2000 – Passed Certified Facility Manager examination

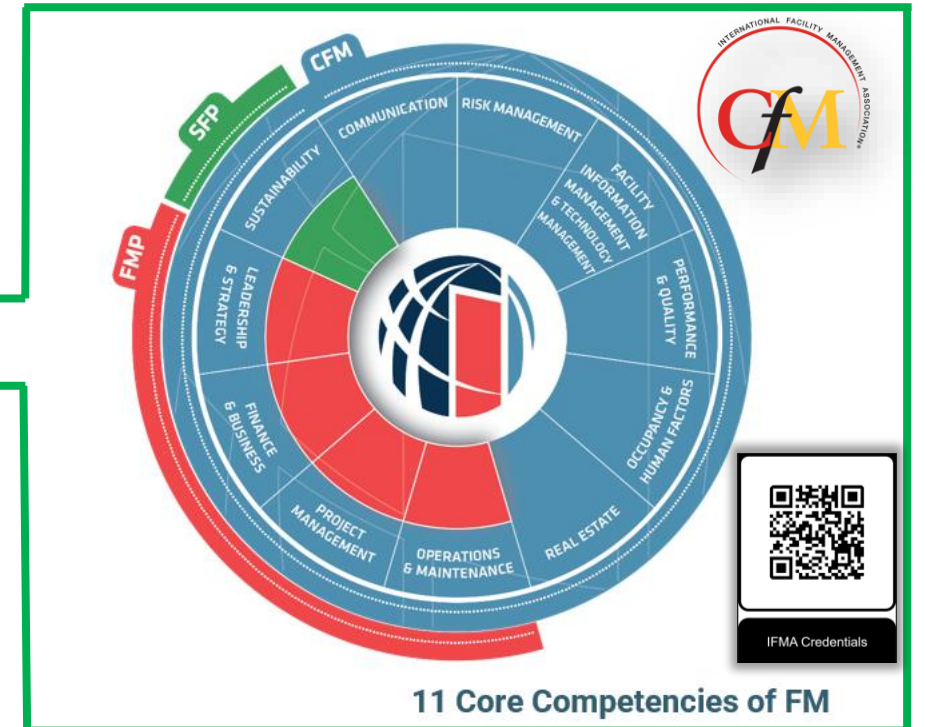
2005 – Received appointment to serve on IFMA Global Board of Directors
